SFPD 4.07 effective July 1, 2008

- Senate Bill 13—Career Technical Education Certification
 - Does 9-12 project contain CTE facilities?
 - If yes, list
 - If no, how are the CTE facility needs of students housed in the project met.
 - Meeting date of CTE Advisory Committee (*Education Code Section 8070*)
- Quarterly Reports provided to Office of Public School Construction

Process and Forms

SFPD 4.17 effective May 1, 2008

- Required if:
 - Master plan capacity changes
 - Facilities deleted/reduced in project

- Discussions include:
 - Educational specifications
 - Title 5 regulations

November 3, 2008 Bond Elections

- 55% vote
 - 80 Measures
 - \$23+ billion
- Parcel Taxes
 - 20 measures

- Since 1998
 - \$40 billion
 - \$29 billion due to 55% vote

Algebra

- On July 9, 2008, the State Board of Education approved the proposal to require all eighth grade students to be assessed in Algebra I within three years.

Algebra

Superintendent of Public Instruction
Jack O'Connell estimates the cost to
be over \$3.1 billion.

- \$369 million for facilities
 - Expansion of Morgan-Hart Class Size reduction to 7th and 8th grade pre-algebra and algebra
 - More space for counselors
