Change of Scope

Change of Scope statement on application for new construction (SFPD Form 4.07)

1. The LEA will provide written notification and revised plans if the scope of the project is changed and affects a standard contained in *California Code of Regulations* Title 5, Section 14030, such as:

Change of Scope

- Number, location, size, type, use and phasing of buildings/classrooms
- Traffic flow
- Parking lot design change
- School Bus drop-off/pick-up locations
- Parent drop-off/pick-up locations
- Fire access routes
- Service vehicle routes

Change of Scope

2. The CDE will review the changes, and if appropriate, issue a supercede plan approval letter.

The supercede letter may be used as evidence of CDE approval of a scope change as required by the Office of Public School Construction on the Project Information Worksheet

Supercede Request

- New Form 4.17
- Purpose is to assist districts in providing CDE with the information necessary to review supercede request.
 - Change in master plan capacity
 - Change in scope such as:
 - Building deleted
 - Change in orientation, location, etc.
 - Effective on supercede request submitted after May 1, 2008

Changes to Form 4.07

- Career Technical Education (CTE)
 - Senate Bill 13 (Wyland)
- Starting July 1, 2008
 - Districts to indicate if CTE facilities included in project
 - sectors and pathways
 - If no CTE facilities, explain why
