 - Senate Version–in mark up

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

- K-12 facilities--\$14 billion
- Technology – \$1 Billion (2 years)
- Charters--\$25 Million Credit Enhancements

- California allocation estimated \$1.6 billion
- Distributed to Local Education Agencies (LEA) based on Part A of Title 1, minimum distribution \$5,000

TIMELINE

- Federals to send funds to state within 30 days after enactment
- States to send to LEAs within 30 days
- LEA to have 50% of funds under contract within one year
- LEA to have all funds under contract within two years

- Supplement not Supplant
- Equitable portion of LEA allocation to charter schools

- American with Disabilities Act
- Fire alarm system
- Asbestos and lead based paint abatement
- Mold remediation
- Technology infrastructure

- Energy conservation
- Pedestrian access
- Other work to facilities that:
 - Improve teachers' ability to teach and students' ability to learn
 - Ensure the health and safety of students and staff
 - Improve energy efficiency
 - Reduce class size

- Maintenance costs
- Competitive athletic facilities
- Facilities where admission is charged to the general public

- U.S. Steel preference

- Develop a plan to develop a database of an inventory of public school facilities
- Develop a school energy efficiency plan
