




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Joint Use

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Joint Use

- **Remaining Proposition 47 Funds**
 - \$33.8 MILLION*
- **Proposition 55 Funds**
 - \$50 MILLION

* As of February 25, 2004

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Joint Use

- **SB 1795 – Joint Use under LPP**
 - SAB gave a one-year extension to program (May 31, 2004)
 - Remaining Funds: \$19.5 MILLION
 - Grant Amounts (state share only)
 - \$191/sf for toilet, food service, kitchen
 - \$105/sf for other facilities

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Joint Use

- **SB 1795 Filing Deadline: May 31, 2004**
Submissions must include:
 - SAB Form 506 JU
 - DSA Approved Plans and Specs
 - Jt. Use Facility Agreement
 - CDE Final Approval Letter, CDE-Certified Project Eligible Square Footage
 - Site Development Worksheet for Additional Grants

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Joint Use

➤ SB 15 changes to the Joint Use Program

– Applicable regulations for projects are determined by the date of the SAB approval

– Changes to Type I, Type II

– Definition: Reconfiguration

“remodeling an existing school building within its current confines and/or the expansion of the square footage of the existing building and any necessary replacement of displaced classrooms or other MEF.”

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Joint Use

➤ SB 15 changes to the Joint Use Program

– Joint Use Partner Contribution

• Minimum contribution of 25%

• District can opt to contribute full 50% of local share *if the district has passed a local bond that specifies such monies will fund the joint use project*

• State will not provide matching share for financial hardship districts

• COEs may participate if the Joint Use partner contributes the local share

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
