**A Resolution in Support of the Passage of K-12/Higher Education
Statewide Bond Measure (Proposition 1D, Kindergarten-University Public
Education Facilities Bond Act of 2006) on the November 2006 Ballot**

WHEREAS, California's public schools face severe overcrowding; and

WHEREAS, more than 60 percent of California's schools are 25 years of age or older and require major repairs; and

WHEREAS, the State Architect has identified more than 7,000 school buildings that could need upgrades to be earthquake-safe; and

WHEREAS, adequate educational facilities are critical to preparing students for the workplace and high wage jobs; and

WHEREAS, the State estimates that the need to build new schools and repair older schools total more than \$11 billion over the next five years; and


WHEREAS, the backlog of school district applications awaiting funding to repair old schools exceeds \$400 million and is growing monthly; and


WHEREAS, our community colleges, state universities and college and university system need additional funding to build new classrooms and repair older facilities;
