

RESOLUTION NO. 23 , 2006-07

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE
ELK GROVE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSITION 1D**

WHEREAS , the Kindergarten-University Public Education Facilities Bond Act of 2006 – provides \$10.4 billion in bonds to relieve overcrowding, reduce class size and repair and upgrade California's elementary middle and high schools, community colleges and universities; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 Statewide Bond measure package is to repair, upgrade and build new school facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Unified School District is projected to receive upwards of \$200,000,000 million from Proposition 1D funding; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1D is needed to build new classrooms to relieve already overcrowded schools and accommodate a projected 8,000-10,000 new students by 2010 in the Elk Grove Unified School District; and,

WHEREAS, many existing schools are in need of repair and upgrading, and Proposition 1D is needed to fix leaky roofs, repair broken bathrooms, upgrade inadequate electrical and fire alarm systems, install heaters and air conditioning, improve earthquake safety, upgrade facilities to comply with ADA, and wire classrooms for the technology and computers our kids need to meet academic standards and compete in the modern workforce; and


WHEREAS, Proposition 1D provides matching funds to Elk Grove Unified School District to maximize Measure A and developer fee dollars that have already or will soon pass local school construction bond measures; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 Statewide School Bond will provide funding to build a better learning environment for our children and is a wise investment in providing adequate facilities; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 Statewide School Bond funds must be spent on school construction, not on overhead, and projects must comply with strict accountability requirements, including mandatory audits.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Elk Grove Unified School District supports Proposition 1D, the Kindergarten-University Public Education Facilities Bond Act of 2006.
