**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING PROPOSITION 1D - KINDERGARTEN-UNIVERSITY  
PUBLIC EDUCATION FACILITIES BOND ACT OF 2006**

**WHEREAS**, California's public school face severe overcrowding; and

**WHEREAS**, more than 60 percent of California's schools are 25 years of age or older and require major repairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Architect has identified more than 7,000 school buildings that could need upgrades to be earthquake safe; and

**WHEREAS**, adequate educational facilities are critical to preparing students for the workplace and high wage jobs; and

**WHEREAS**, the State estimates that the need to build new schools and repair older schools totals more than \$11 billion over the next five years; and

**WHEREAS**, the backlog of school district applications awaiting funding to repair old schools exceed \$400 million and is growing monthly; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education of the Lake Elsinore Unified School District supports passage of a K-12/Higher Education statewide bond measure for the November 2006 ballot.


