

**VACAVILLE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
RESOLUTION NO. 5, 2006-2007**

**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSITION 1D,
STATEWIDE SCHOOL FACILITIES GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND
ON NOVEMBER 7, 2006 BALLOT**

WHEREAS, California's public schools face severe overcrowding; and

WHEREAS, more than 60 percent of California's schools are 25 years of age or older and require major repairs; and

WHEREAS, the State Architect has identified more than 7,000 school buildings that could need upgrades to be earthquake safe; and

WHEREAS, adequate educational facilities are critical to preparing students for the workplace and high wage jobs; and

WHEREAS, the State estimates that the need to build new schools and repair older schools totals more than \$11 billion over the next five years; and

WHEREAS, the backlog of school district applications awaiting funding to repair old schools exceed \$400 million and is growing monthly; and

WHEREAS, our community colleges, state universities and college and university system needs additional funding to build new classrooms and repair older facilities; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1D, as approved by the State Legislature, is a \$10.416 billion bond measure, which will provide funding for K-12 and higher education new construction and modernization needs; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1D provides up to \$1.9 billion in new construction funding for K-12 school facilities; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1D provides up to \$3.3 billion in renovation and modernization funding for K-12 school facilities; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1D provides another \$2.3 billion for other specified uses including charter schools, career technical facilities, joint use projects, overcrowded schools and higher performance design incentives; and

WHEREAS, the Vacaville Unified School District's Measure V local general obligation bond program depends on State matching funds from statewide general obligation bonds that are approved by the State's voters to complete new construction and renovation project plans.

NOW, HEREBY BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Board of the Vacaville Unified School District supports passage of Proposition 1D, the K-12/Higher Education statewide bond measure for the November 7, 2006 ballot.

PASSED AND ADOPTED this 7th day of September 2006 by the Vacaville Unified School District Board of Education of Solano County, California, by the following vote:


